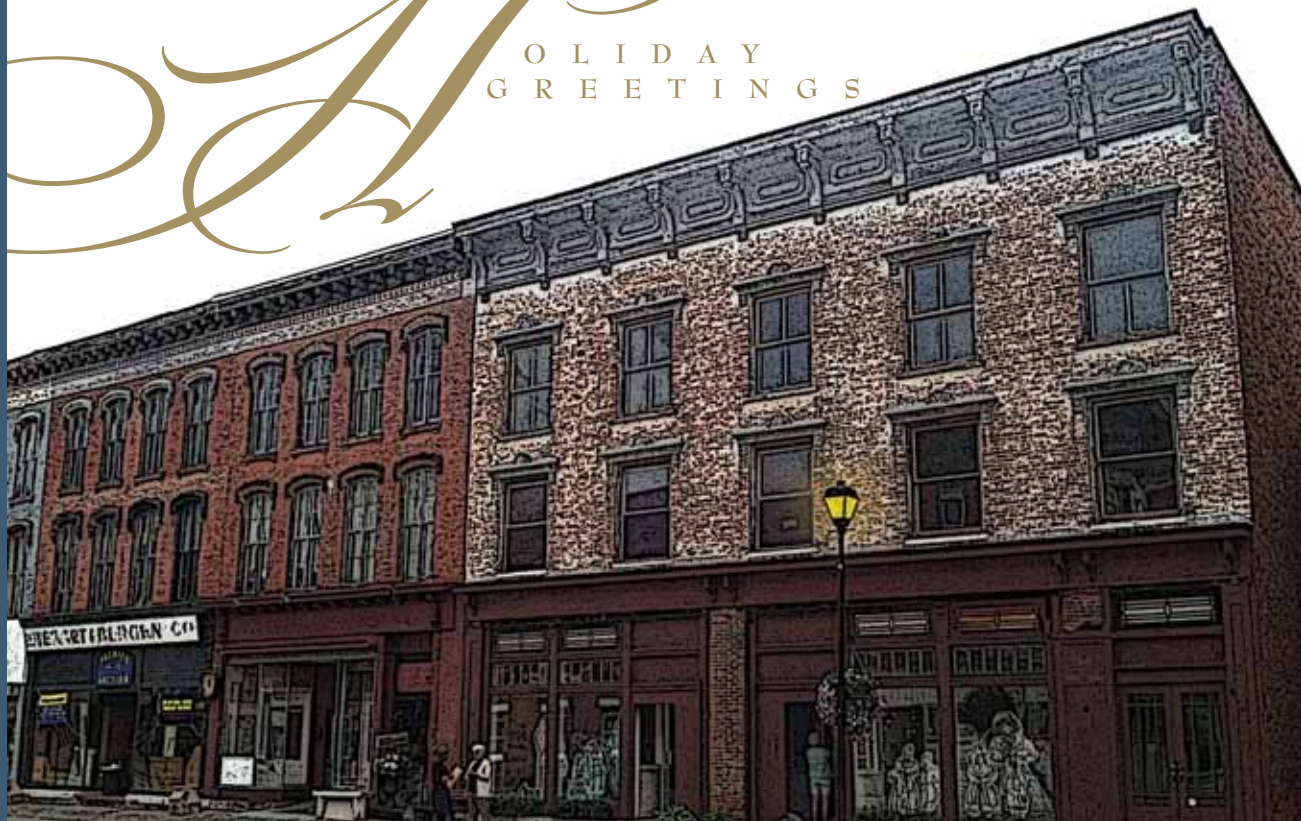

ON THE COVER: 47 Main Street, Fort Plain, New York, a canal town on the Mohawk River, where the League has educated the community and facilitated the preservation and revitalization of Fort Plain's historic downtown:

- 2007:** The League presented a lecture on the benefits of historic preservation.
- 2009:** The League presented its popular workshop Enhancing Main Street: Making Upper Floors Work Again and awarded the Village a Preserve New York grant to support a cultural resource survey of the Village of Fort Plain.
- 2011:** The League awarded the Village a grant from the Donald Stephen Gratz Preservation Services Fund for a feasibility study of adaptive use alternatives for 47 Main Street and a Preserve New York grant to complete a National Register Historic District nomination for the village of Fort Plain.

The League's work in Fort Plain is an excellent example of the importance of historic preservation. Preservation protects our history and heritage, attracts reinvestment in existing buildings, and is a driving force in the needed economic revitalization of New York's historic cities, towns, and villages.
